REGISTRATION:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector residing in the Delton Kellogg School District of Orangeville Township who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Orangeville Township Clerk, the Office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office or other designated state agency; or can use the Online Voter Registration System at www.Michigan.gov/vote.

Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is MONDAY, July 21, 2025 (MCL 168.497)

After July 21, 2025, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency up to and including through the day of election (MCL 168.492) at the Orangeville Clerk's office at the following times:

Please take notice that the following proposal will appear on the ballot:

Delton Kellogg Schools Operating Millage Renewal Proposal:

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 19.1592 mills (\$19.1592 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Delton Kellogg Schools, Barry and Allegan Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2026 to 2030, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and the 18 mills are levied in 2026 is approximately \$4,250,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2025 tax levy)?
