

Orangeville Township Cemetery Rules & Enforcement

- The Sexton will pour all cemetery foundations for headstones
- Nothing to be planted on graves more than 10" from headstone
- Urns must be placed in line beside headstone
- No climbing plants, trees or bushes (including rose bushes) to be planted on grave
- No fences, stones, landscape timbers/borders, mounds or barriers may be erected/placed around headstones or on a burial plot
- No decorations prior to April 1st
- Remove all plastics by October 1st
- All plants must be planted in ground or in urns
- No plastic vases or pots unless they are staked in ground

A violation of the above rules will be enforced as follows:

1. A red tag outlining the violation shall be dated and placed on each plot in violation allowing 30 days for violation to be corrected
2. A written notice of violation will be sent to the record owner of a burial site when possible
3. If corrections are not made at conclusion of said 30-day period, the Grounds Keeper shall remove the violation and dispose of said item

Above cemetery rules supersede previous rules and are now effective
