The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is MONDAY, October 19, 2026. (MCL 168.497)

After October 19, 2026, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency up to and including through the day of election (MCL 168.492) at the Orangeville Clerk's office at the following times:
